

## **Troy Christian Prom Dress Code For Students and their Guests**

**Students and guests MUST be in compliance and sign this form to be admitted to Prom.**

Prom is a formal evening. Our guys do not need to wear tuxes, but collared shirts with ties and dress pants; sport coats or suits are the attire for the evening. (Of course if a guy wants to rent a tux, go ahead.) Our ladies are to wear long or short dresses. Please follow these guidelines:

- If your dress is short, remember it needs to be at least to the top of the knee.
- If your dress has a slit, it may come up only to the top of your knee (same as the length).
- If your dress is cut low on the back, be sure it is no lower than the middle of your back.
- If you have see-through fabric, be sure it is an overlay. There must be another fabric layer underneath.
- If your dress is cut low in the front, be sure no cleavage is showing.
- You may wear a dress with spaghetti straps or that is strapless – just remember that you'll want to be comfortable, as well as modest.

**Modesty is the key to dressing to please the Lord, and is a guideline of Troy Christian Schools. Students will need to meet these dress standards to enter the Prom. Parents, please make sure your student is appropriately dressed for this great evening.**

## **Troy Christian Conduct Expectations For Students and their Guests**

1. There will be no use of tobacco in any form, alcoholic beverages, pornographic materials, hallucinogenic drugs and substances, marijuana, or narcotics not prescribed by a doctor. Students may not share prescription or non-prescription drugs.
2. Gambling is not acceptable in any form.
3. Discrimination against or harassment of others on a basis of race, national origin, gender, or disability is not acceptable.
4. Any kind of humiliating acts, verbal or other threat of violence, physical attack or inappropriate sexual advances directed toward another person will not be tolerated.
5. Weapons are not to be on school property or brought to any school sponsored function.
6. Students and guests will be respectful of TCS property, and the property or possessions of others. Vandalism is not tolerated.
7. Students will show proper respect for members of TCS faculty and staff, as well as the staff of off-campus event venues.
8. Students must use school transportation to Prom and After Bash – cars and keys are left at the high school.
