Kindergarten Intervention

We recognize that each child is a unique creation of God, and that not all children learn in the same way or at the same rate of speed. Through a collaborative team effort, our intervention teachers work with classroom teachers to problem-solve and make decisions concerning students who are having some difficulty with the regular curriculum. Our intervention program is designed to improve skills in reading, math, language arts, writing, study skills, and organization through small group and/or individual instruction. The curriculum will be modified and individual plans developed when necessary.

Speech Pathologist

Kindergarten students that need assistance in their language and speech development are individually evaluated by the Troy Christian Schools' speech pathologist.

Enrichment Classes

Elementary children are offered many enrichment opportunities in a variety of settings at no or minimal cost. Examples of opportunities including Legos, chess, physical fitness, reading clubs, and homework helpers.

Assistants

Troy Christian Schools is dedicated to providing an excellent teacher/student ratio in each classroom. In doing so, many classrooms have a trained assistant that teams with the teacher throughout the day.

In order to meet the needs of each child and his or her family, we offer a variety of excellent educational programs for this age group.

- * Pre-Kindergarten
- * Half-Day Kindergarten
- * All-Day Kindergarten



The Pre-Kindergarten program is designed for the child who is five years old by December 31 . This program is designed for the child who is age appropriate for Kindergarten but needs another year to develop either socially, physically, emotionally, or academically. Giving the child the gift of another year provides:

- * An environment for a successful experience
- * A strong sense of self-confidence and self-esteem
- * Activities designed to meet individual needs, interest, and styles of learning
- * Increase their skills in problem-solving, decision-making, memory comprehension and creativity.
- * Curriculum allowing freedom of expression through play, creative materials, large and small muscle materials, and manipulative games and toys
- * Integrated phonics and phonological awareness for reading
- * Science centers, math activities, art, drama, and music
- * Christian character and Bible lessons

All of these experiences provide educational opportunities to enhance and enrich the individual development of the child.



Kindergarten Screening

In the best interest of our new students, children applying to a Kindergarten program participate in a screening which gives the teachers an overall view of the child's readiness and skill levels.

Our All-Day Kindergarten program coordinates with our Half-Day Kindergarten to provide the same curriculum and experiences so that both programs provide an excellent foundation for First Grade. The Kindergarten program is designed for the child that is five years old by July 31 . The entire Kindergarten program:

- * Is presented through a Biblical worldview
- * Emphasis on the development of character
- * Includes a phonetic-based reading program which teaches sounds, blending those sounds into words, and reading stories
- * Basic writing skills, applying beginning capitals and ending marks, along with traditional handwriting instruction
- * Fundamental math facts and concepts
- * Science, social studies, health, and art are integrated
- * Instruction by special teachers in music, physical education and computer

In the afternoon program, differentiated learning is offered to meet the needs of the individual students. It includes:

- * Both reinforcement and enrichment activities
- * Additional hands-on experiences
- * Centers to expand concepts
- * Small group activities
